You Will Need: Foam pad or sponge to work on, a sewing needle, thread, black beads, red and black wool roving, a felting needle, wooden skewer and scissors.



2
Roll a piece of black wool into a 2 in. long body. It helps to use a skewer while you roll the wool so that it is tight.



3
Slide the body off the skewer and needle the surface to help hold the shape.



4
Measure a 2 in. piece of red wool for each of the four wings.



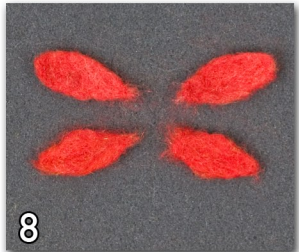
5
Fold the wool in half so that it is nicely rounded at one end.



6
Needle the wing to make it smooth, flat and narrow.



7
One end of the wing is curved and the other end narrow. Leave the fibers loose at the narrow end to help attach the wing to the body.



8
Make four wings.



9
Position the wings on the back of the dragonfly.



10
Needle the loose fibers of the wing into the body to attach.



11
Sew black beads on each side of the dragonfly's head for eyes.



12
That's it. You're done. If you want a hanging dragonfly, sew some thread through the body, make a loop and tie a knot.
